Order

WHEREAS, Maritime Electric Company Limited (the "Company") has applied to the Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission (the "Commission") for approval of the issue of \$60.0 million in long term first mortgage bonds;

AND WHEREAS, the Company seeks to raise \$60.0 million through the issuance of first mortgage bonds with an interest rate not to exceed 6.50% and a term not to mature later than 30 years from date of issuance;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 12(2) of the *Electric Power Act*, the Commission may grant approval of a proposed issue:

AND WHEREAS, the Commission has reviewed the application and concludes the issuance as just and reasonable for the operations of the Company;

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the *Island Regulatory* and Appeals Commission Act and the *Electric Power Act*,

IT IS ORDERED THAT

- Approval is hereby granted for the Company to proceed with the issuance and sale of first mortgage bonds provided that;
 - a. the principal amount is not to exceed \$60.0 million,
 - b. the interest rate is not to exceed 6.50% per annum, and
 - c. the issue is not to mature later than 30 years.

 The Company shall file with the Commission, upon completion of the issue and sale of the first mortgage bonds, a copy of all documents delivered at the closing of the transaction.

NOTICE

Section 12 of the *Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission Act* reads as follows:

12. The Commission may, in its absolute discretion, review, rescind or vary any order or decision made by it or rehear any application before deciding it.

Parties to this proceeding seeking a review of the Commission's decision or order in this matter may do so by filing with the Commission, at the earliest date, a written Request for Review, which clearly states the reasons for the review and the nature of the relief sought.

Sections 13.(1) and 13(2) of the Act provide as follows:

- 13.(1)An appeal lies from a decision or order of the Commission to the Appeal Division of the Supreme Court upon a question of law or jurisdiction.
- (2) The appeal shall be made by filing a notice of appeal in the Supreme Court within twenty days after the decision or order appealed from and the Civil Procedure Rules respecting appeals apply with the necessary changes.
