IN THE MATTER of an application by Irving Oil Marketing Limited for a decrease of 3.6 cents per litre in its propane pricing schedule.

Order

UPON receiving the application of Irving Oil Marketing Limited ("Irving") for a decrease of 3.6 cents per litre in all prices in its propane pricing schedule based on decreased acquisition costs;

AND UPON reading the Declaration of Claudette Maxwell, Pricing Representative for Irving, and supporting documentation filed herein on October 24, 2006;

AND UPON it appearing to the Commission that the prices resulting from a decrease of 3.6 cents per litre in Irving's propane pricing schedule are just and reasonable;

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the *Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission Act* and the *Petroleum Products Act*,

IT IS ORDERED THAT

- 1. the maximum propane prices charged by Irving Oil Marketing Limited, effective 12:01 a.m. on Wednesday, November 1, 2006, be in accordance with Appendix "A" to this Order, and shall remain in effect until otherwise ordered by the Commission; and
- **2.** the prices approved herein shall appear on all invoices covering sales or deliveries of propane.

NOTICE:

Section 58 of the *Petroleum Products Act* reads as follows:

58. Where any person has the status of a party or is an intervenor in any hearing before the Commission, he is entitled

(a to appeal the decision of the Commission to the Appeal Division; and

(b) to participate as a party in the hearing of an appeal.

and an appeal shall be on a question of law or jurisdiction only and be governed by section 13 of the Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission Act.

Sections 13.1 (1) and (2) of *the Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission Act* provide as follows:

13.(1) An appeal lies from a decision or order of the Commission to the Appeal Division of the Supreme Court upon a question of law or jurisdiction.

(2) The appeal shall be made by filing a notice of appeal in the Supreme Court within twenty days after the decision or order appealed from and the Civil Procedure Rules respecting appeals apply with the necessary changes.
