# Order

**UPON** receiving the application of Irving Energy Distribution and Marketing ("Irving") on March 30, 2009 for a decrease of 4.5 cents per litre in all prices in its propane pricing schedule based on decreased costs;

**AND UPON** it appearing to the Commission that the prices resulting from a decrease of 4.5 cents per litre in Irving's propane pricing schedule are just and reasonable;

**NOW THEREFORE**, pursuant to the *Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission Act* and the *Petroleum Products Act*,

# IT IS ORDERED THAT

- 1. the maximum propane prices charged by Irving Energy Distribution and Marketing, effective 12:01 a.m. on Wednesday, April 1, 2009, be in accordance with Appendix "A" to this Order, and shall remain in effect until otherwise ordered by the Commission; and
- **2.** the prices approved herein shall appear on all invoices covering sales or deliveries of propane.

### NOTICE:

#### Section 58 of the Petroleum Products Act reads as follows:

**58.** Where any person has the status of a party or is an intervenor in any hearing before the Commission, he is entitled

(a to appeal the decision of the Commission to the Appeal Division; and

(b) to participate as a party in the hearing of an appeal.

and an appeal shall be on a question of law or jurisdiction only and be governed by section 13 of the Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission Act.

#### Sections 13.1 (1) and (2) of the Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission Act provide as follows:

13.(1) An appeal lies from a decision or order of the Commission to the Appeal Division of the Supreme Court upon a question of law or jurisdiction.

(2) The appeal shall be made by filing a notice of appeal in the Supreme Court within twenty days after the decision or order appealed from and the Civil Procedure Rules respecting appeals apply with the necessary changes.
