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# Order

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**UPON** receiving the application of Irving Energy Distribution and Marketing ("Irving") on May 29, 2009 for a decrease of 0.7 cent per litre in all prices in its propane pricing schedule based on decreased costs;

**AND UPON** it appearing to the Commission that the prices resulting from a decrease of 0.7 cent per litre in Irving's propane pricing schedule are just and reasonable;

**NOW THEREFORE**, pursuant to the *Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission Act* and the *Petroleum Products Act*,

## IT IS ORDERED THAT

1. the maximum propane prices charged by Irving Energy Distribution and Marketing, effective 12:01 a.m. on Monday, June 1, 2009, be in accordance with Appendix "A" to this Order, and shall remain in effect until otherwise ordered by the Commission; and
2. the prices approved herein shall appear on all invoices covering sales or deliveries of propane.

**NOTICE:****Section 58 of the *Petroleum Products Act* reads as follows:**

**58.** *Where any person has the status of a party or is an intervenor in any hearing before the Commission, he is entitled*

*(a) to appeal the decision of the Commission to the Court of Appeal; and*

*(b) to participate as a party in the hearing of an appeal.*

*and an appeal shall be on a question of law or jurisdiction only and be governed by section 13 of the Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission Act.*

**Sections 13.1 (1) and (2) of the *Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission Act* provide as follows:**

*13.(1) An appeal lies from a decision or order of the Commission to the Court of Appeal upon a question of law or jurisdiction.*

*(2) The appeal shall be made by filing a notice of appeal in the Court of Appeal within twenty days after the decision or order appealed from and the rules of court respecting appeals apply with the necessary changes.*
