**IN THE MATTER** of prices charged by wholesaler licensees for petroleum products;

# AND

**IN THE MATTER** of applications by Irving Energy Distribution and Marketing, Kenmac Energy Inc., Superior Plus Inc. (dba Superior Propane), Parkland Fuel Corporation (dba Island Petroleum) and Noonan Petroleum Ltd. regarding propane pricing.

# Order

**UPON** reviewing and considering current international, national and regional market and related conditions;

**AND UPON** it appearing to the Commission that:

- 1) A continuation in all gasoline prices currently in effect in both the dealer and consumer schedules;
- 2) A continuation of the diesel prices currently in effect in both the dealer and consumer schedules; and
- 3) A continuation of the furnace fuel and stove oil prices currently in effect in the consumer schedule;

will result in prices that are just and reasonable;

# AND UPON receiving:

- 1) The application of Irving Energy Distribution and Marketing (Irving) on October 8, 2019 for an increase of 0.4 cents per litre (cpl) in its propane pricing schedule based on increased costs;
- The application of Kenmac Energy Inc. (Kenmac) on October 7, 2019 for an increase of 1.3 cpl in its propane pricing schedule based on increased costs;
- The application of Superior Plus Inc. (Superior) on October 8, 2019 for an increase of 1.6 cpl in its propane pricing schedule based on increased costs;
- The application of Parkland Fuel Corporation (Island Petroleum) on October 7, 2019 for an increase of 1.6 cpl in its propane pricing schedule based on increased costs; and
- 5) The application of Noonan Petroleum Ltd (Noonan) on October 8, 2019 for an increase of 1.3 cpl in its propane pricing schedule based on increased costs;

**AND UPON** it also appearing to the Commission that:

- 1) An increase of 0.4 cpl in Irving's propane schedule;
- 2) An increase of 1.3 cpl in Kenmac's propane schedule;
- 3) An increase of 1.6 cpl n Superior's propane schedule;
- 4) An increase of 1.6 cpl in Island Petroleum's propane schedule; and
- 5) An increase of 1.3 cpl in Noonan Petroleum's propane schedule;

will result in prices that are just and reasonable;

**NOW THEREFORE**, pursuant to the *Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission Act* and *the Petroleum Products Act*;

# IT IS ORDERED THAT

- 1. the prices contained in the attached Dealer Petroleum Prices Schedule shall be effective 12:01 a.m. on Friday, October 11, 2019;
- 2. the prices contained in the attached Posted Consumer Petroleum Prices Schedule shall be the maximum prices charged by the respective licensee, effective 12:01 a.m. on Friday, October 11, 2019;
- 3. the attached dealer prices, with H.S.T. added, shall be indicated on all documents accompanying deliveries of these products;
- 4. effective 12:01 a.m. Friday, October 11, 2019, the maximum propane prices charged by:
  - a. Irving Energy Distribution and Marketing be in accordance with Appendix "A" to this Order;
  - b. Kenmac Energy Inc. be in accordance with Appendix "B" to this Order;
  - c. Superior Plus Inc. be in accordance with Appendix "C" to this Order;
  - d. Parkland Fuel Corporation be in accordance with Appendix "D" to this Order; and
  - e. Noonan Petroleum Ltd. be in accordance with Appendix "E" to this Order;
- 5. the propane prices approved herein shall appear on all invoices covering sales or deliveries of propane; and
- 6. the prices determined in this Order, with adjustments resulting from tax changes only, shall remain in effect until otherwise ordered by the Commission.

#### NOTICE:

#### Section 58 of the *Petroleum Products Act* reads as follows:

**58.** Where any person has the status of a party or is an intervenor in any hearing before the Commission, he is entitled

(a to appeal the decision of the Commission to the Court of Appeal; and

(b) to participate as a party in the hearing of an appeal.

and an appeal shall be on a question of law or jurisdiction only and be governed by section 13 of the Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission Act.

# Sections 13 (1) and (2) of *the Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission Act* provide as follows:

13.(1) An appeal lies from a decision or order of the Commission to the Court of Appeal upon a question of law or jurisdiction.

(2) The appeal shall be made by filing a notice of appeal in the Court of Appeal within twenty days after the decision or order appealed from and the rules of court respecting appeals apply with the necessary changes.

The information in this Order is confidential until the price changes take effect. Any unauthorized use or communication of this information by licensees or their employees, and in particular, any disclosure of the contents of this Order to the public, or to the media, prior to 12:01 a.m. on the date in which these price changes come into effect, is strictly prohibited, and may result in license suspension or monetary penalty.
