# Order

**WHEREAS** this matter was scheduled for hearing before the Commission on May 29, 2018;

**AND WHEREAS** the Appellant failed to appear at the hearing;

**AND WHEREAS** the record confirms that the Appellant received notice of the date and time of the hearing by the following:

### **NOTICE**

Sections 26(2), 26(3), 26(4) and 26(5) of the **Rental of Residential Property Act** provides as follows:

- (2) A lessor or lessee may, within fifteen days of the decision of the Commission, appeal to the court on a question of law only.
  - (3) The rules of court governing appeals apply to an appeal under subsection (2).
  - (4) Where the Commission has confirmed, reversed, or varied an order of the Director and no appeal has been taken within the time specified in subsection (2), the lessor or lessee may file the order in the court.
  - (5) Where an order is filed pursuant to subsection (4), it may be enforced as if it were an order of the court.

### **NOTICE**

In accordance with the Commission's Records Retention and Disposition Schedule, the material contained in the official file regarding this matter will be retained by the Commission for a period of two (2) years.
