Pardon my late response on the PEIEC EE&C Plan; unfortunately I didn't get more than a cursory look at it. My main concern with it is the lack of planning to reduce the peak demand; encouraging purchase of household heat pumps will continue to add to the peak demand. I hope that proper peak demand reduction programs will be in PEIEC's followup DSM plan. PEIEC should be directed to develop and submit DSM planning asap.

If IRAC holds a public hearing on the PEIEC EE&C Plan, it would be an excellent IRAC initiative to provide funding for a PUBLIC INTEREST INTERVENOR. (I'm not intending to apply.)

Regarding MECL's 2019 Capital Budget recently filed for approval, there should definitely be a public hearing, and definitely funding for a PUBLIC INTEREST INTERVENOR. Roger King would be an excellent candidate for that position in both cases.
