



NOTICE OF PROPOSAL – *Rural Municipality of Darlington*

TAKE NOTICE that the Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission (the “Commission”) has received a proposal to dissolve a municipality (the “Proposal”) from the Rural Municipality of Darlington (the “Municipality”) pursuant to section 15 of the *Municipal Government Act*, RSPEI 1988, c M-12.1 (the “Act”).

BACKGROUND

The Municipality proposes to dissolve. The Proposal states that “it is no longer feasible for the community to sustain itself without a significant tax increase”.

The estimated population of the Municipality is 100 individuals.
