I want to make known my disappointment in the decision that is likely to be made, without proper public involvement and reasonable due process, regarding docket UE20723. The request made by Maritime Electric to put the Diesel Combustion Turbine CT4 is one that is short-sighted and disregards the greener options available. This pricey expenditure is one that should not be rushed into nor rushed through the process because of pressures from the purchasing party's (Maritime Electric) insistence and desire for a quick, simple and dirty option.

I do not wish to question the research that shows the need for additional on-island power generation. Nor do I wish to question the power cable concerns to the mainland. My concerns and public outcry lies with the Commission's willingness to ignore reasonable and verified greener/more environmentally sustainable options.
