— PETROLEUM PRICING —

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, January 8, 2021 - The Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, January 8, 2021:

- The price of gasoline will increase by 2.0 cents per litre (cpl);
- There is no change to the price of furnace oil; and
- The price of diesel will decrease by 1.1 cpl.

At self-serve outlets, prices for regular unleaded gasoline will range from 107.4 to 108.6 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 111.4 to 112.6 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 81.3 cpl.

The Commission's next scheduled pricing adjustment is January 15, 2021.
