— PETROLEUM PRICING —

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, January 15, 2021 - The Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, January 15, 2021:

- The price of gasoline will increase by 3.5 cents per litre (cpl);
- The price of furnace oil will increase by 4.2;
- The price of diesel will increase by 4.3 cpl; and
- Propane prices will increase by 2.9 cpl for Irving Energy Distribution and Marketing; by 4.4 cpl for Superior Propane; by 3.3 cpl for Island Petroleum; and by 3.5 cpl for both Kenmac Energy Inc. and Noonan Petroleum.

At self-serve outlets, prices for regular unleaded gasoline will range from 111.4 to 112.6 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 116.4 to 117.5 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 85.7 cpl.

Propane prices will range from 81.3 to 82.7 cpl.
