— PETROLEUM PRICING —

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, January 29, 2021 - The Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, January 29, 2021:

- The price of gasoline will increase by 1.0 cents per litre (cpl);
- There is no change to the price of furnace oil or diesel; and
- Propane prices will increase by 4.9 cpl for Irving Energy Distribution and Marketing; by 4.0 cpl for Superior Propane; by 5.2 cpl for Island Petroleum; and by 4.1 cpl for both Kenmac Energy and Noonan Petroleum.

At self-serve outlets, prices for regular unleaded gasoline will range from 112.6 to 113.7 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 117.5 to 118.7 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 86.7 cpl.

Propane prices will range from 86.2 to 86.8 cpl.
