## — PETROLEUM PRICING —

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, February 5, 2021 - The Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, February 5, 2021:

- The price of gasoline will increase by 1.0 cents per litre (cpl); and
- The price of both furnace oil and diesel will increase by 1.5 cpl.

At self-serve outlets, prices for regular unleaded gasoline will range from 113.7 to 114.9 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 119.3 to 120.4 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 88.3 cpl.
