The following is distributed by Island Information Services at the request of the Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission:

— PETROLEUM PRICING —

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, April 23, 2021 - The Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, April 23, 2021:

- There is no change to the price of gasoline;
- The price of both furnace oil and diesel will increase by 2.1 cents per litre (cpl); and
- Propane prices will decrease by 0.3 cpl for Superior Propane; by 1.6 cpl for Island Petroleum; by 1.3 cpl for Irving Energy Distribution and Marketing; and by 2.6 cpl for both Kenmac Energy and Noonan Petroleum.

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 127.0 to 128.1 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 124.4 to 125.6 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 93.0 cpl.

Propane prices will range from 84.9 to 86.0 cpl.
