— PETROLEUM PRICING —

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, May 14, 2021 - The Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, May 14, 2021:

- There is no change to the price of gasoline;
- The price of furnace oil will increase by 1.0 cents per litre (cpl); and
- The price of diesel will increase by 1.5 cpl.

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 130.4 to 131.6 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 127.3 to 128.5 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 95.1 cpl.

The Commission's next scheduled pricing adjustment is May 21, 2021.
