## — PETROLEUM PRICING —

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, May 28, 2021 - The Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, May 28, 2021:

- The price of gasoline will decrease by 2.0 cents per litre (cpl);
- There is no change to the price of furnace oil; and
- The price of diesel will decrease by 1.0 cpl.

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 128.1 to 129.3 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 126.2 to 127.3 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 95.1 cpl.
