Notice of Application

PEI Energy Corporation Seeks Approval of Electricity Efficiency & Conservation Plan

The PEI Energy Corporation ("PEIEC") has filed an application with the Prince Edward Island Regulatory & Appeals Commission requesting approval of a new Electricity Efficiency & Conservation Plan ("EE&C Plan").

DETAILS

The EE&C Plan, proposed to be in effect for three years beginning April 1, 2022, is expected to produce net electricity savings of approximately 34.45 GWh and 16.85 MW of net demand savings during the three-year term.

The estimated cost of the EE&C Plan is \$24.52 million of which \$2.6 million is to be billed to customers of Maritime Electric and collected through a rate rider on electric bills.

A public hearing will not be held unless the Commission determines it is necessary. If a public hearing is to be held, a Notice of Hearing will be published. Otherwise, the Commission will issue an Order on the application which will be published on the Commission website at irac.pe.ca/electric/ue41401/.
