As you know, on June 3, 2025, the Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission (the "Commission") received a request from the Applicant, Maritime Electric Company, Limited ("MECL"), to enter into settlement negotiations with your client, Prince Edward Island Energy Corporation ("PEIEC").

By letter to the parties dated June 25, 2025, the Commission directed PEIEC to advise of its position on MECL's request by no later than 4:00 p.m. on July 3, 2025.

On July 3, 2025, PEIEC requested a two-week extension to advise of their position which was granted by the Commission. PEIEC's submission was due on July 17, 2025.

On July 17, 2025, PEIEC requested a further extension to advise the Commission of its position with respect to the negotiated settlement to July 22, 2025. In support of its request for an extension, PEIEC states that the brief extension will enable PEIEC to be in a position to respond substantively to MECL's request.

The Commission is satisfied that PEIEC's request for a brief extension is, in the circumstances, reasonable. The request for an extension is granted, and PEIEC will have until **4:00 p.m. on July 22, 2025** to advise of its position on MECL's request to negotiate.
