Further to my correspondence of December 23, 2025, the Commission has reviewed in detail Maritime Electric Company, Limited's ("Maritime Electric") confidential filings submitted in response to Commission Order UE25-07.

As previously noted, Commission Order UE25-07 was thorough and authorized only the limited redactions set out therein. The confidential filings submitted by Maritime Electric do not comply with the limited redactions approved by the Commission.


Maritime Electric cannot unilaterally vary or amend a Commission Order. If Maritime Electric seeks to make additional redactions to the filings, in addition to those approved by the Commission, an application is required to vary Order UE25-07, pursuant to section 12 of the *Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission Act*.

In the interest of time, Maritime Electric is required to either apply to vary Order UE25-07, or fully comply with the Order, by no later than **4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, January 13, 2026**.

To clarify, an application to vary Order UE25-07 is not required with respect to the additional redactions to Appendices C, D and E of Exhibit M-12 requested by ProEnergy. These proposed redactions are under advisement and will be considered in conjunction with an application to vary, should one be forthcoming.
