Re: D.P. Murphy Inc. – Application for a Retail Petroleum License Commission Docket PD527

We are writing in our capacity as legal counsel for the Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission (the "Commission") in relation to the application filed by D.P. Murphy Inc. (the "Applicant") seeking a retail petroleum license.

On June 24, 2024, the Applicant filed a Market Overview & Analysis prepared by Deloitte, together with an Acknowledgement of Expert's Duty form and the profile of Chris Robertson, CPA. A copy of these documents were provided to the interveners and have been made publicly available on the Commission website.

At this time, the Commission requires each of the **interveners** to advise in writing, no later than 4:00 p.m. on July 26, 2024:

- 1. Whether it intends to retain an expert or file any evidence or written submissions with respect to this matter; and
- 2. If an expert will be retained, the identity of the expert and the proposed date that the expert's report will be filed.

In addition, **all parties** must provide the following information in writing, no later than 4:00 p.m. on July 26, 2024:

- 1. The identity of any witnesses that it intends to call, should a public hearing be held;
- 2. The nature of each witnesses' testimony; and
- 3. The number of hearing days required.

Once this information is received, the Commission will determine whether a public hearing will be held, and will establish timelines for procedural steps.
