RE: Docket UE20742 – Response to PEIEC’s Extension Request to Provide Written Submissions Re. Work-in-Progress Deferral Account

The Commission acknowledges receipt of your letter dated March 20, 2026 requesting an extension for the Prince Edward Island Energy Corporation (“PEIEC”) to make written submissions to the Commission regarding MECL’s request for a Work-in-Progress Deferral account in relation to the On-Island Capacity for Security of Supply Supplemental Capital Budget Request (Docket UE20742).

In the request, PEIEC noted that despite diligent efforts it would be difficult to complete the submission by the original deadline of March 20, 2026, in part due to internal reorganization within Government that has affected PEIEC. PEIEC also indicated that the additional time would assist in provided a more comprehensive submission.

The Commission has considered the request and the circumstances outlined therein and finds the request reasonable. Accordingly, the Commission approves the requested extension. The Commission notes the importance of maintaining timely progress in this proceeding and expects that the revised deadline will support the efficient advancement of the record. PEIEC’s responses shall be filed with the Commission and served on all parties no later than Friday April 3, 2026.
