**Re: D.P. Murphy Inc. – Application for a Retail Petroleum License
Commission Docket PD527**

By letter dated July 2, 2024, the Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission (the "Commission") requested certain procedural information from the Applicant and the interveners in Docket PD527. At the request of the intervener, Ceretti's Grocery & Hardware Ltd. ("Ceretti's"), the timeline to respond to the information requests was extended from July 26, 2024 to August 26, 2024.

On August 26, 2024, the Commission received a further request for an extension on behalf of the intervener, Howatt's Tourist Mart Ltd. ("Howatt's"). Howatt's advised that they needed additional time to review the Applicant's expert report, and to obtain certain reports and data that were referenced in the expert report but not yet filed with the Commission.

On August 29, 2024, the parties were advised that the Commission was considering granting an extension until September 27, 2024. The parties were given the opportunity to provide input on the proposed extension before a decision was made.

Although Ceretti's consented to the proposed extension, the Applicant objected and filed written reasons for the objection with the Commission.

The Commission has considered the submissions of the parties and has determined that the request for a further extension is, in the circumstances, reasonable. The extension will allow the parties additional time to review the Applicant's expert report, including underlying reports and data that were not initially filed with the Commission.

As such, the procedural timelines set forth in the Commission's July 2, 2024 correspondence are hereby further extended from August 26, 2024 to **September 27, 2024**. This extension shall apply to all parties.
