RE: Docket UE20742 – On-Island Capacity for Security of Supply Project – Request for Friend of the Commission Intervener Status

On December 18, 2024, Maritime Electric Company, Limited ("MECL") filed an application with the Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission (the "Commission") seeking approval of their On-Island Capacity for Security of Supply Project.

Following receipt of the Application, the Commission gave public notice through a publication in local newspapers and on the Commission website. In the notice, the Commission invited interested parties to request intervener status, in accordance with the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure. Requests for intervention were to be submitted by April 4, 2025.

The Commission received 3 requests for intervener status by the deadline stated in the notice. On April 14, 2025, Ecology Action Centre submitted a request for Friend of the Commission intervener status.

Although the Commission recognizes the valuable contribution of the Ecology Action Centre as it relates to alternative methods of increasing dispatchable capacity resources without investment in a Combustion Turbine and RICE plant, the Commission is not prepared to grant intervener status to the Ecology Action Centre application received after the April 4, 2025 deadline. This does not prevent the Ecology Action Centre from applying for intervener status in future applications.

The Commission encourages Ecology Action Centre to continue following the developments of Docket UE20742 on the Commission's website, as there may be additional opportunities to provide written submissions to the Commission on this matter.
