

**Re: Utilities Docket UE20742
MECL's Application re a Supplemental Budget Request for On-Island Capacity
MECL's Request for a Deferral Account**

1. We write on behalf of the Prince Edward Island Energy Corporation (the "PEIEC") with respect to the Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission's (the "Commission") variation to order UE25-07 dated March 10, 2026 ("Order UE25-07A") on the above noted Application (the "Application") by Maritime Electric Company, Limited ("MECL").
2. In Order UE25-07A, the Commission decided, amongst other matters, MECL's application to vary Order UE25-07. Order UE25-07A also provided all Interveners an additional opportunity to make written submissions to the Commission respecting MECL's request for a Work-in-Progress (WIP) Deferral Account, and directed that such submissions be made by Friday, March 20, 2026.
3. Despite diligent efforts, the PEIEC will not be in a position to submit written submissions by end of day March 20, 2026. This is in part due to internal reorganization in Government that impacted the PEIEC.
4. The PEIEC therefore respectfully requests an extension from March 20, 2026, to April 3, 2026 to file its submissions regarding the deferral account request.

5. This two-week extension will allow PEIEC additional time for internal review and with Government, enabling a more comprehensive submission on this request from the PEIEC.
6. If the Commission grants this extension, the PEIEC is likewise agreeable to the Friend of the Commission Interveners receiving the same extension to make their respective submissions.
7. We look forward to the Commission's direction on this issue.
