As per our meetings, conversations, and your letter dated August 7, 2017 (that outlined your conditions for an extension), please be advised that Island Waste Management Corporation approves your proposal for the extension of the Capital and Central (combined) Waste and Compost Collection Contract originally dated November 1, 2012.

Superior Sanitation Services Ltd. (Superior) and Island Waste Management Corporation (IWMC) hereby agree to the following:

- Superior and IWMC agree to extend the existing IWMC Compost and Waste Collection Contract for Capital and Central (combined), scheduled to expire on October 31, 2019, for an additional 5-year term (November 1, 2019 - October 31, 2024).
- IWMC and Superior agree that the rates per household, cottage, extended cottage and special collections will be as outlined below for each year/term of the extension period. Changes represent a 1.7% increase per contract year.

- All payments including monthly contract payments and annual housing and fuel adjustments will be processed based on the terms of the original contracts or any amendments made to the original contracts.
- Superior will replace the existing collection trucks servicing collections in this area with new 2018 collection trucks.
- All terms and conditions of the original collection contract including any amendments made to the original contract will remain in place for the duration of the contract extension term.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF the parties hereto agree to this extension of the Island Waste Management Corporation's combined Capital and Central Collection Contract for Compost and Waste Collections. Both Parties have executed this AGREEMENT on January 16, 2019.

Dear Gerry:

In 2012 Superior Sanitation responded to a tender call for the Capital and Central Regions combined collection, transportation of residential waste and organics. Superior was successful in obtaining this contract.

At the time of this tender Superior anticipated fulfilling the seven year contract with (9)- 2013 International trucks equipped with the (maxforce 9 engines) which have not proved out. With two years remaining in the contract Superior has two options:

1. To utilize the current 2013 units and purchase additional used backup units or
2. To purchase 11 - new 2018 units.

In order to utilize option #2 Superior would need to extend the existing contract for a full seven years commencing on November 1, 2017. Years 6 and 7 would be at the existing contract pricing and years 8 through 12 would be at a 1.7% annual increase (the same annual increase that is in the existing contract).

Note:

The Consumer Price Index for Prince Edward Island excluding energy has averaged 1.78% for the last five years.


Superior in the tender call in 2012 was 19% lower than its current existing competitor.

Superior has been working with International trucks to receive an Incentive Package to remove these units from our fleet. Superior has received an Incentive Package that will expire the week of August 14th, 2017. A response positive or negative to this request prior to this date would be greatly appreciated.

In my own opinion the addition of 11 new units would put a positive outlook on the commitment that Superior and IWMC would have for the residents of Prince Edward Island.
