REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIALITY

INTRODUCTION

1. Maritime Electric Company, Limited (“Maritime Electric” or the “Company”) is a public utility subject to the *Electric Power Act* engaged in the production, purchase, transmission, distribution and sale of electricity within Prince Edward Island.
2. On December 18, 2024, Maritime Electric applied for an order of the Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission (the “Commission”) approving a supplementary capital budget request for the On-Island Capacity for Security of Supply Project (Exhibit M-1, “the Original Filing”).
3. By correspondence dated May 16, 2025 (Exhibit M-7) and May 28, 2025 (Exhibit M-8), Maritime Electric requested that Appendices E & F of the Original Filing and IR-2d and IR-2e of Exhibit M-6 be disclosed to the Commission and the Added Party Intervenor Prince Edward Island Energy Corporation (“PEIEC”) but otherwise remain confidential.
4. On August 14, 2025, Maritime Electric filed additional evidence detailing a new and time-sensitive opportunity that had arisen (Exhibit M-12, “the Supplemental Filing”).
5. On September 16, 2025 Maritime Electric filed a Request for Confidentiality (Exhibit M-13).

6. On December 5, 2025 the Commission issued Order UE25-07 in response to Maritime Electric's request for confidentiality.
7. On December 17, 2025 Maritime Electric filed its updated public and confidential documents in response to Order UE25-07.
8. On January 8, 2026 the Commission advised Maritime Electric's redactions exceeded the scope of UE25-07 and that a request to vary UE25-07 was required.
9. On March 10, 2026, following further submissions from Maritime Electric, the Commission issued Order UE25-07A varying Order UE25-07.
10. On March 13, 2026, Maritime Electric filed its updated public and confidential documents in response to Order UE25-07A.
11. On March 20, 2026, Maritime Electric advised the Commission of changes to the pricing and delivery timelines related to the Accelerated On-Island Capacity Development Solution ("ProEnergy Opportunity").
12. On April 17, 2026 Maritime Electric provided the Commission with further details on those changes and an updated proposal from ProEnergy (collectively, the "Updated Information").
13. The Updated Information necessitates updates to certain of Maritime Electric's confidential filings, specifically Exhibit M-12 Tables 1 and 2 and Appendices C, D and E ("the Confidential Filings").
14. Maritime Electric is of the view that Order UE25-07A permits the update of the Confidential Filings without the requirement for an additional confidentiality order from the Commission, with the exception of the following:
 - (a) The additional pricing information contained at Page 8 of the Updated Confidential Appendix C;
 - (b) The Progress Billing table contained at Page 8 of the Updated Confidential Appendix C; and
 - (c) The Engineering Procurement and Construction Progress Billing table contained at Page 9 of the Updated Confidential Appendix C.(collectively, the "New Information").

15. Maritime Electric hereby requests an order of the Commission permitting the New Information to be disclosed to the Commission and Added Party Intervenor but otherwise filed on a confidential basis.

LEGAL PRINCIPLES

16. In Maritime Electric's supplemental request for confidentiality dated September 16, 2025 (M-13), Maritime Electric provided a detailed review of the legal principles relevant to a request for confidentiality. Maritime Electric relies upon those legal principles in this submission.

Pricing Information

17. The pricing information on page 8 (formerly on page 9) of the Updated Appendix C was approved to be redacted in UE25-07A. However, the updated document has broken down the pricing information into the Equipment Supply Scope and the Engineering Procurement and Construction Supply Scope. Maritime Electric's opinion is that the redaction of the pricing information, in its entirety, is consistent with Order UE25-07A.

Equipment Progress Billing Table

18. The ProEnergy Equipment Progress Billing table on page 8 of the Updated Appendix C was previously not included. However, the same table was and remains included in Appendix D and was approved to be redacted. Maritime Electric's opinion is that the redaction of the information contained in the ProEnergy Equipment Progress Billing table is consistent with the Order UE25-07A.

EPC Progress Billing Table

19. The ProEnergy EPC Progress Billings table on page 9 of the Updated Appendix C was previously not included. Maritime Electric's opinion is that this table is an extension to the ProEnergy Equipment Progress Billing table on page 8 discussed above and therefore warrants the same confidential treatment, whereas as per Order UE25-07A "all columns in the ProEnergy Payments table are to be redacted except for the column headings."

CONCLUSION

20. In sum, Maritime Electric submits that the New Information is related to and consistent with the information ordered to remain confidential in Order UE25-07A and therefore should be disclosed to the Commission and the Added Party Intervenor but otherwise remain confidential.
