Good morning,

My name is Quentin Bevan, and I own and operate Bevan Bros. Plumbing and Heating, Olympia Electric, Weymouth Properties, and Dave's Auto Electric.

As a small business owner, I have always taken a reliable supply of electricity for granted. However, I believe that is something we can no longer afford to take for granted. PEI's electricity demand has grown significantly, and with continued population growth and increased reliance on electricity, particularly for heating, it is clear that our need for reliable capacity will continue to grow.

I believe wind, solar, and battery storage all have an important role to play in PEI's future energy supply. However, these resources alone cannot provide the dependable, on-demand capacity that is required during periods of peak demand or when electricity imports are constrained.

For these reasons, I believe Maritime Electric's proposal to install two 50 MW combustion turbines is a responsible and reasonable solution to address PEI's current and growing capacity needs. The ability to have reliable, dispatchable generation available when it is needed will provide greater security for Island residents and businesses and help ensure that our electricity system can keep pace with future growth.

As a business owner, I believe reliable electricity is fundamental to the ability of businesses to operate, grow, and invest in PEI. I strongly support Maritime Electric's proposal and respectfully ask the Commission to approve the application.
