**To the Commission Clerk:**

Please find attached my formal Letter of Comment regarding the active Maritime Electric application under Docket UE20742 (On-Island Capacity).

As the Commission evaluates this \$334 million application, this submission argues that it is fiscally irresponsible to approve this public debt without comparative due diligence. The attached letter formally requests that the Commission pause the docket and mandate the PEI Energy Corporation (PEIEC) to commission an independent engineering and financial study into a 100 MW marine-import firm capacity asset located at the Georgetown shipyard.

Crucially, this submission asks IRAC to ensure the study evaluates multiple ownership models—Private Utility, Investment Utility, and Public Utility—to determine the best value for ratepayers, while also evaluating the site's unique geographic synergy for net-zero wastewater cooling.

I request that this letter be filed on the official public docket for the Commissioners' review prior to any final regulatory decision.
