In the past four years there has been an increase in population in PEI of 25 Thousand people which means a substantial increase in revenue for Waste Watch. An increase may be necessary but not 12%. On another matter the sub division I live in located in Rustico is zoned seasonal. Because of this we have to pay for snow removal, gravel road repair etc which comes to over \$1000.00 a year for each person as the Dept. of highways does not pay for any of this.
