## **Government of Prince Edward Island Announces Review of Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission**

**Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, May 14, 2026** – The Government of Prince Edward Island has announced today that there will be a review of the Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission and its current mandate.

As the Island's independent regulator, the Commission has a broad set of responsibilities under several PEI statutes, with regulatory, administrative, and appellate functions across many matters that are important to Islanders. The Commission is proud of the work we do to fulfill this mandate with integrity, impartiality, and fairness and we are proud of the Commission staff who perform their duties with professionalism and expertise.

As a quasi-judicial administrative tribunal, the Commission must uphold the independence and integrity that are essential ingredients in fulfilling its important role in PEI. We will engage with the review to the best of our ability while ensuring that the Commission's independence is upheld. We look forward to receiving more details about the review process once they are available.

At this time, operations at the Commission should not be affected by the review and we will continue to operate normally with a focus on our responsibilities to Prince Edward Islanders.

While the review is underway, the Commission will not be providing further comment as we allow this important process to unfold.
