Re: LA23002 – Withdrawal of Appeal LA17008

Dear Ms. Walsh-Doucette:

I have considered paragraphs 30-32 in the Order No: LA23-09¹ and wish to withdraw my former appeal, LA17008, dated November 11, 2017.

Appeal LA17008 was in response to a previous decision by the province and is no longer relevant given the province's more recent decisions of December 13, 2022 for the same structures.

Since LA23002 is my appeal of the December 13, 2022 denial decisions², I do not wish to confuse the issues, and in respecting IRAC's procedure, I do not wish to add to the costs and complexities of the proceedings.

I agree with paragraphs 30-31 that recent decisions by the province³ and a change in circumstances makes the outstanding appeals no longer relevant.

² The December 13, 2022 decisions being appealed under LA23002 relate to the denials of three accessory buildings, permits M-2022-0160 (A2) M-2022-0161 (A3), and M-2022-0162 (A4).

³ The December 13, 2022 decisions recognized the change in circumstances and approved permit M-2022-0158 for the Cottage (subject of appeal LA18014) with a condition that "all previously issued permits for the structure(s) are null and void."
