Notice of Hearing

Application to Increase Electricity Rates to Collect Additional Operating and Capital Costs Related to Hurricane Fiona

Maritime Electric Company, Limited has filed an application with the Commission seeking approval to increase electricity rates to recover additional operating and capital costs from ratepayers resulting from Hurricane Fiona.

BACKGROUND

Maritime Electric submits that its actual operating and capital costs to complete the Fiona restoration was \$37 million. Maritime Electric is seeking approval to recover these additional costs from ratepayers beginning March 1, 2024. As this date has passed, if approved, the Commission will determine the appropriate effective date, if any, as part of its decision on this matter. If approved, the Fiona-related costs will result in an incremental annual cost increase of approximately 2.4% for customers. The actual rate impact for an individual customer will vary depending on the customer's energy consumption and demand.
