



Notice of Hearing

Maritime Electric's On-Island Capacity Project

Maritime Electric Company, Limited has filed an application with the Prince Edward Island Regulatory & Appeals Commission seeking approval of its proposed On-Island Capacity for Security of Supply Project ("the Project"). This application was filed in December 2024. At the time of filing, the estimated cost for this project was \$427 million USD.

In August 2025, Maritime Electric submitted a supplemental filing, revising the project to propose an accelerated On-Island capacity solution. The supplemental filing seeks Commission approval for Maritime Electric to proceed with the revised proposed projects and, if approved, to recover the associated costs from ratepayers through future electricity rates. The project in the supplemental filing has an estimated cost of \$353 million USD.

If the supplemental filing is not approved, Maritime Electric has requested that the Commission consider its original application.

ABOUT THE APPLICATION AND SUPPLEMENTAL FILING

In December 2024, Maritime Electric submitted an application for an On-Island Security of Supply Project, which sought approval for procurement of:

- A 10 MW/40 MWh Battery Energy Storage System;
- A 50 MW Combustion Turbine; and
- A 90 MW Reciprocating Internal Combustion Engine plant.

If approved, the Project would add 150 MW of on-Island dispatchable electrical capacity.

In August 2025, Maritime Electric submitted a supplemental filing proposing an accelerated On-Island capacity solution. The supplemental filing amended the original application by seeking approval for the procurement of:

- two (2) 50 MW Combustion Turbines.

If approved, the project would provide 100 MW of on-Island dispatchable electrical capacity. The turbines will serve as peaking and backup generation capacity to support reliability, respond to unplanned system events, comply with NB Power Hold-to-schedule requirements, and facilitate planned maintenance.

The public hearing will consider Maritime Electric's application, including the supplemental filing submitted in August 2025.
