PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, April 17, 2026 – The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission would like to remind consumers, retailers, and wholesalers that the applicable federal excise tax rate will be suspended effective April 20, 2026. As a result, 10.0 cpl will be removed from gasoline products (regular, mid-grade and premium) and 4.0 cpl will be removed from diesel effective 12:01 a.m., Monday, April 20, 2026.

The Commission continues to remind consumers that market conditions remain fluid with the state of global conflicts. The Commission continues to monitor these conditions daily to ensure that prices are fair for consumers and wholesalers/retailers and that consistent supply is available across the province.
