PRICE ADJUSTMENT RELATED TO TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF PROVINCIAL TAX ON GASOLINE AND DIESEL FUELS

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, September 25, 2026 – The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission is advising petroleum consumers that the Government of Prince Edward Island has announced amendments to the rate of tax imposed under the *Gasoline Tax Act* on gasoline and diesel sold in Prince Edward Island effective September 26, 2026. As a result, there will be a price adjustment effective at 12:01 AM on Saturday, September 26, 2026 to remove the provincial tax from these products.

The amendments to the rate of tax imposed under the *Gasoline Tax Act* include further adjustments to be effective at future dates. The Commission will issue Orders in accordance with the amendments on such dates.

The chart below summarizes the announced changes in the provincial tax portion on all grades of gasoline and diesel fuel that are effective from September 26, 2026 until January 31, 2027.
