



Notice of Application Maritime Electric 2022 Annual Capital Budget

Maritime Electric Company, Limited has filed an application with the Commission seeking approval of its 2022 Annual Capital Budget.

Background

Under section 17(1) of the *Electric Power Act*, Maritime Electric is required to submit to the Commission for approval its 2022 Annual Capital Budget of proposed improvements or additions to the property of the public utility.

Details

Maritime Electric is seeking approval of capital expenditures of \$40,066,000.00. The proposed capital expenditures are as follows:

Corporate	\$4,035,000
Capitalized General Expense	\$690,000
Interest During Construction	\$496,000

A public hearing will not be held unless the Commission determines it is necessary. If a public hearing is to be held, a Notice of Hearing will be published. Otherwise, the Commission will issue an Order on the application which will be posted on the Commission website at irac.pe.ca/electric.
