PETROLEUM PRICING INTERRUPTION

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, September 22, 2026 – The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission would like to advise consumers in Prince Edward Island that there will be an unscheduled price change (interruption), **effective 12:01 AM on Wednesday, September 23, 2026** on the following petroleum products:

- Furnace Oil
- Diesel

As noted recently, global events have resulted in market volatility, which sometimes requires unscheduled pricing adjustments (interruptions). The Commission adopted the practice of providing advance notice if there will be an unscheduled price adjustment (interruption). This advance notice will include the products being adjusted and the effective date of the adjusted pricing.

The Commission has adopted this practice on a permanent basis to provide as much pricing stability and certainty to retailers and consumers as possible, especially when markets are experiencing increased volatility.
