

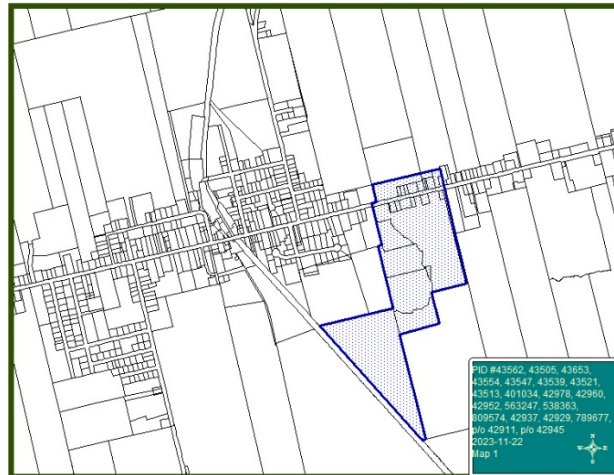


Notice of Proposal Town of O'Leary

The Town of O'Leary has submitted a proposal to restructure (the "Proposal") to the Prince Edward Island Regulatory & Appeals Commission under section 15 of the *Municipal Government Act* (the "Act").

BACKGROUND

The Town proposes to restructure by annexing 20 parcels of land totaling approximately 77 acres. The Proposal states the estimated population of the area that may be affected is approximately 10 individual residences. The proposal lists the unincorporated area of Unionvale as being affected by the Proposal. The area affected by this Proposal can be viewed in the following map:

Any individual or municipality wishing to respond to the proposal can do so by submitting Form MGA-MR-2 (Response to a Proposal to Establish, Restructure, Dissolve a Municipality) to the Commission by **4:00 p.m. on January 2, 2024**. All comments received by the Commission will be made public and posted on the Commission website.
