

NOTICE OF PROPOSAL

Rural Municipality of St. Louis

TAKE NOTICE that the Rural Municipality of St. Louis (the "Municipality") has submitted a proposal to the Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission (the "Commission") to dissolve (the "Proposal") pursuant to section 15 of the *Municipal Government Act*, RSPEI 1988, c M-12.1 (the "Act").

BACKGROUND

The Municipality proposes to dissolve. The Proposal states that "it is no longer financially feasible to remain as a municipality without a significant tax increase to the small population of the Municipality."

The Proposal states that existing municipalities and unincorporated areas which may be affected include St. Edward, Alma, Miminegash, Palmer Road and Elmsdale.

The estimated population of the Municipality is 75 individuals.
