



NOTICE OF PROPOSAL Rural Municipality of Crapaud Single Parcel Annexation (part of PID 405480)

TAKE NOTICE that the Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission (the "Commission") has received a proposal to restructure (the "Proposal") from the Rural Municipality of Crapaud (the "Municipality") pursuant to section 15 of the *Municipal Government Act*, RSPEI 1988, c M-12.1 (the "Act").

BACKGROUND

The Municipality proposes to annex a portion of a single parcel of land totaling approximately 27.6 acres located on the TransCanada Highway. The parcel is owned by the Community of Crapaud. There will be no initial increase to the Municipality's population, if approved.
