



NOTICE OF PROPOSAL Annexation of Lands *Rural Municipality of Kinkora*

TAKE NOTICE that the Rural Municipality of Kinkora (the "Municipality") has submitted a proposal to the Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission (the "Commission") to restructure (the "Proposal") pursuant to section 15 of the *Municipal Government Act*, RSPEI 1988, c M-12.1 (the "Act").

BACKGROUND

The Municipality proposes to annex five parcels of land totaling approximately 33.69 acres located in the unincorporated area of Newton. The properties include: a portion of PID 282053 owned by David J McIver and Sylvia McIver and being approximately 3.47 acres, a portion of PID 876698 owned by Leonard McCardle Inc. and being approximately 16.95 acres, a portion of PID 273458 owned by the Regional Administration School Unit Two and being approximately 6.35 acres, PID 779934 owned by the Municipality and being approximately 6.55 acres, and PID 778662 owned by K-Right Communications Ltd. and being approximately 0.37 acres.

There will be no initial increase to the Municipality's population, if approved.
