- 1. In accordance with Orders WM21-01 and WM21-01R, Island Waste Management Corporation ("IWMC" or the "Company") is required to file a Cost Allocation Analysis no later than September 15, 2021.
- 2. On September 1, 2021, IWMC wrote to the Commission requesting an extension of the filing deadline for the Cost Allocation Analysis from September 15, 2021 to October 6, 2021.
