IN THE MATTER of applications by Irving Energy Distribution and Marketing, Kenmac Energy Inc., Superior Plus Inc. (dba Superior Propane), Parkland Fuel Corporation (dba Island Petroleum) and Noonan Petroleum Ltd. regarding propane pricing.

UPON reviewing and considering current international, national and regional market and related conditions;

AND UPON it appearing to the Commission that:

- 1) A decrease in the gasoline prices currently in effect in both the dealer and consumer schedules of 4.5 cents per litres (cpl);
- 2) A decrease in the diesel prices currently in effect in both the dealer and consumer schedules of 25.0 cpl; and
- 3) A decrease in the furnace fuel and stove oil prices currently in effect in the consumer schedule of 25.0 cpl;

will result in prices that are just and reasonable;

AND UPON receiving:

- 1) The application of Irving Energy Distribution and Marketing (Irving) on May 17, 2022, for a decrease of 0.8 cpl in its propane pricing schedule based on decreased costs;
- The application of Kenmac Energy Inc. (Kenmac) on May 16, 2022, a decrease of 1.4 cpl in its propane pricing schedule based on decreased costs;
- The application of Superior Plus Inc. (Superior) on May 17, 2022, for a decrease of 1.2 cpl in its propane pricing schedule based on decreased costs;
- 4) The application of Parkland Fuel Corporation (Parkland) on May 13, 2022, for a decrease of 5.0 cpl in its propane pricing schedule based on decreased costs; and
- 5) The application of Noonan Petroleum Ltd. (Noonan) on May 17, 2022, for a decrease of 1.4 cpl in its propane pricing schedule based on decreased costs;

AND UPON it also appearing to the Commission that:

- 1) A decrease of 0.8 cpl in Irving's propane schedule;
- 2) A decrease of 1.4 cpl in Kenmac's propane schedule;
- 3) A decrease of 1.2 cpl in Superior's propane schedule;
- 4) A decrease of 5.0 cpl in Parkland's propane schedule; and
- 5) A decrease of 1.4 cpl in Noonan's propane schedule;

will result in prices that are just and reasonable;

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the *Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission Act* and *the Petroleum Products Act*;

IT IS ORDERED THAT

- 1. the prices contained in the attached Retail Dealer Pump Prices Schedule shall be effective 12:01 a.m. on Friday, May 20, 2022;
- 2. the prices contained in the attached Maximum Consumer Petroleum Prices Schedule shall be the maximum prices charged by the respective licensee, effective 12:01 a.m. on Friday, May 20, 2022;
- 3. the attached dealer prices, with H.S.T. added, shall be indicated on all documents accompanying deliveries of these products;
- 4. effective 12:01 a.m. Friday, May 20, 2022, the maximum propane prices charged by:
 - a. Irving be in accordance with Appendix "A" to this Order;
 - b. Kenmac be in accordance with Appendix "B" to this Order;
 - c. Superior be in accordance with Appendix "C" to this Order;
 - d. Parkland be in accordance with Appendix "D" to this Order; and
 - e. Noonan be in accordance with Appendix "E" to this Order;
- 5. the propane prices approved herein shall appear on all invoices covering sales or deliveries of propane; and
- 6. the prices determined in this Order, with adjustments resulting from tax changes only, shall remain in effect until otherwise ordered by the Commission.

NOTICE:

Section 58 of the Petroleum Products Act reads as follows:

58. Where any person has the status of a party or is an intervenor in any hearing before the Commission, he is entitled

(a) to appeal the decision of the Commission to the Court of Appeal; and

(b) to participate as a party in the hearing of an appeal.

and an appeal shall be on a question of law or jurisdiction only and be governed by section 13 of the Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission Act.

Subsections 13(1) and (2) of the Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission Act provide as follows:

13.(1) An appeal lies from a decision or order of the Commission to the Court of Appeal upon a question of law or jurisdiction.

(2) The appeal shall be made by filing a notice of appeal in the Court of Appeal within twenty days after the decision or order appealed from and the rules of court respecting appeals apply with the necessary changes.

Any unauthorized use or communication of this information by licensees or their employees, and in particular, any disclosure of the contents of this Order to the public, or to the media, prior to 12:01 a.m. on the date in which these price changes come into effect, is strictly prohibited, and may result in license suspension or monetary penalty.
