UPON reviewing and considering current international, national and regional market and related conditions;

AND UPON it appearing to the Commission that:

- 1) An increase in the gasoline prices currently in effect in both the dealer and consumer schedules of 3.0 cents per litres (cpl);
- 2) No change in the diesel prices currently in effect in both the dealer and consumer schedules; and
- 3) No change in the furnace fuel and stove oil prices currently in effect in the consumer schedule;

will result in prices that are just and reasonable;

AND UPON receiving:

- 1) The application of Irving Energy Distribution and Marketing (Irving) on November 1, 2022, for a decrease of 1.8 cpl in its propane pricing schedule based on decreased costs;
- 2) The application of Superior Plus Inc. (Superior) on November 1, 2022, for a decrease of 0.9 cpl in its propane pricing schedule based on decreased costs;
- The application of Kenmac Energy Inc. (Kenmac) on October 31, 2022, for a decrease of 0.8 cpl in its propane pricing schedule based on decreased costs;
- The application of Parkland Fuel Corporation (Parkland) on October 28, 2022, for an decrease of 3.0 cpl in its propane pricing schedule based on decreased costs; and
- 5) The application of Noonan Petroleum Ltd. (Noonan) on October 31, 2022, for a decrease of 0.8 cpl in its propane pricing schedule based on decreased costs;

AND UPON it also appearing to the Commission that:

- 1) A decrease of 1.8 cpl in Irving's propane schedule;
- 2) A decrease of 0.9 cpl in Superior's propane schedule;
- 3) A decrease of 0.8 cpl in Kenmac's propane schedule;
- 4) A decrease of 3.0 cpl in Parkland's propane schedule; and
- 5) A decrease of 0.8 cpl in Noonan's propane schedule;

will result in prices that are just and reasonable;

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the *Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission Act* and *the Petroleum Products Act*;

IT IS ORDERED THAT

- 1. the prices contained in the attached Retail Dealer Pump Prices Schedule shall be effective 12:01 a.m. on Friday, November 4, 2022;
- 2. the prices contained in the attached Maximum Consumer Petroleum Prices Schedule shall be the maximum prices charged by the respective licensee, effective 12:01 a.m. on Friday, November 4, 2022;
- 3. the attached dealer prices, with H.S.T. added, shall be indicated on all documents accompanying deliveries of these products;
- 4. effective 12:01 a.m. Friday, November 4, 2022, the maximum propane prices charged by:
 - a. Irving be in accordance with Appendix "A" to this Order;
 - b. Superior be in accordance with Appendix "B" to this Order;
 - c. Kenmac be in accordance with Appendix "C" to this Order;
 - d. Parkland be in accordance with Appendix "D" to this Order; and
 - e. Noonan be in accordance with Appendix "E" to this Order;
- 5. the propane prices approved herein shall appear on all invoices covering sales or deliveries of propane; and
- 6. the prices determined in this Order, with adjustments resulting from tax changes only, shall remain in effect until otherwise ordered by the Commission.

(2) The appeal shall be made by filing a notice of appeal in the Court of Appeal within twenty days after the decision or order appealed from and the rules of court respecting appeals apply with the necessary changes.
