UPON reviewing and considering current international, national and regional market and related conditions:

AND UPON it appearing to the Commission that:

- 1) A decrease in the gasoline prices currently in effect in both the dealer and consumer schedules of 7.0 cents per litre (cpl):
- 2) No change in the diesel prices currently in effect in both the dealer and consumer schedules; and
- 3) A decrease in the furnace fuel and stove oil prices currently in effect in the consumer schedules of 24.0 cpl;

will result in prices that are just and reasonable;

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission Act and the Petroleum Products Act.

IT IS ORDERED THAT

- 1. the prices contained in the attached Retail Dealer Pump Prices Schedule shall be effective 12:01 a.m. on Thursday, November 10, 2022;
- 2. the prices contained in the attached Maximum Consumer Petroleum Prices Schedule shall be the maximum prices charged by the respective licensee, effective 12:01 a.m. on Thursday, November 10, 2022;
- 3. the attached dealer prices, with H.S.T. added, shall be indicated on all documents accompanying deliveries of these products; and
- 4. the prices determined in this Order, with adjustments resulting from tax changes only, shall remain in effect until otherwise ordered by the Commission.

- (2) The appeal shall be made by filing a notice of appeal in the Court of Appeal within twenty days after the decision or order appealed from and the rules of court respecting appeals apply with the necessary changes.
