UPON reviewing and considering current international, national and regional market and related conditions and notification of the changes in the Federal Fuel Charge;

AND UPON it appearing to the Commission that:

- 1) An increase in the regular gasoline prices currently in effect in both the dealer and consumer schedules of 6.0 cents per litres (cpl);
- 2) An increase in the premium gasoline prices currently in effect in both the dealer and consumer schedules of 5.0 cpl;
- 3) An increase in the diesel prices currently in effect in both the dealer and consumer schedules of 1.0 cpl; and
- 4) An increase in the furnace fuel and stove oil prices currently in effect in the consumer schedule of 1.5 cpl;

will result in prices that are just and reasonable;

And Upon the Government of Canada decreasing the Federal Fuel Charges to petroleum products, including Propane, sold in Prince Edward Island effective April 1, 2025, pursuant to the amendments to Schedule 2 of the Greenhouse Gas Pollution Pricing Act. This will result in a decrease in petroleum products prices on April 1, 2025. The table below shows the price per litre impact by product.

- 4. the prices contained in the attached Maximum Consumer Petroleum Prices Schedule B shall be the maximum prices charged by the respective licensee, effective 12:01 a.m. on Tuesday, April 1, 2025;

- 5. the attached dealer prices, with H.S.T. added, shall be indicated on all documents accompanying deliveries of these products;
- 6. effective 12:01 a.m. <u>Tuesday, April 1, 2025</u>, the maximum propane prices charged by:
 - a. Irving be in accordance with Appendix "A" to this Order;
 - b. Superior be in accordance with Appendix "B" to this Order;
