UPON reviewing and considering current international, national and regional market and related conditions;

AND UPON it appearing to the Commission that:

- 1) A decrease in the regular gasoline prices currently in effect in both the dealer and consumer schedules of 1.0 cents per litres (cpl);
- 2) A decrease in the premium gasoline prices currently in effect in both the dealer and consumer schedules of 2.5 cpl;
- 3) A decrease in the diesel prices currently in effect in both the dealer and consumer schedules of 2.0 cpl; and
- 4) A decrease in the furnace fuel and stove oil prices currently in effect in the consumer schedule of 7.0 cpl;

will result in prices that are just and reasonable;

AND UPON receiving:

- The application of Kenmac Energy Inc. (Kenmac) on April 30, 2025, for no change in its propane pricing schedule;
- 4) The application of Avenir Energy (Avenir) on April 25, 2025, for an decrease of 2.6 cpl in its propane pricing schedule based on decreased costs; and
- 5) The application of Noonan Petroleum Ltd. (Noonan) on April 30, 2025, for no change in its propane pricing schedule;

AND UPON it also appearing to the Commission that:

- 1) A decrease of 4.2 cpl in Irving's propane schedule;
- 2) A decrease of 3.7 cpl in Superior's propane schedule;
- 3) No change in Kenmac's propane schedule;
- 4) A decrease of 2.6 cpl in Avenir's propane schedule; and

- 4. effective 12:01 a.m. Friday, May 2, 2025, the maximum propane prices charged by:
 - a. Irving be in accordance with Appendix "A" to this Order;
 - b. Superior be in accordance with Appendix "B" to this Order;
 - c. Kenmac be in accordance with Appendix "C" to this Order;
 - d. Avenir be in accordance with Appendix "D" to this Order; and
 - e. Noonan be in accordance with Appendix "E" to this Order;
- 5. the propane prices approved herein shall appear on all invoices covering sales or deliveries of propane; and
- 6. the prices determined in this Order, with adjustments resulting from tax changes only, shall remain in effect until otherwise ordered by the Commission.
