UPON reviewing and considering current international, national and regional market and related conditions;

AND UPON it appearing to the Commission that:

- 1) There will be a decrease in the regular gasoline prices currently in effect in both the dealer and consumer schedules of 4.0 cents per litre (cpl);
- 2) There will be a decrease in the premium gasoline prices currently in effect in both the dealer and consumer schedules of 4.0 cpl;
- 3) There will be a decrease in the diesel prices currently in effect in both the dealer and consumer schedules of 5.0 cpl; and
- 4) There will be a decrease in the furnace fuel and stove oil prices currently in effect in the consumer schedules of 5.0;

will result in prices that are just and reasonable;

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the *Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission Act* and the *Petroleum Products Act*;

IT IS ORDERED THAT

1. the prices contained in the attached Retail Dealer Pump Prices Schedule shall be effective 12:01 a.m. on Saturday, April 11, 2026;
2. the prices contained in the attached Maximum Consumer Petroleum Prices Schedule shall be the maximum prices charged by the respective licensee, effective 12:01 a.m. on Saturday, April 11, 2026;
3. the attached dealer prices, with H.S.T. added, shall be indicated on all documents accompanying deliveries of these products; and
4. the prices determined in this Order, with adjustments resulting from tax changes only, shall remain in effect until otherwise ordered by the Commission.

NOTICE:**Section 58 of the *Petroleum Products Act* reads as follows:**

58. Where any person has the status of a party or is an intervenor in any hearing before the Commission, he is entitled

(a) to appeal the decision of the Commission to the Court of Appeal; and

(b) to participate as a party in the hearing of an appeal.

and an appeal shall be on a question of law or jurisdiction only and be governed by section 13 of the Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission Act.

Subsections 13(1) and (2) of the *Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission Act* provide as follows:

13.(1) An appeal lies from a decision or order of the Commission to the Court of Appeal upon a question of law or jurisdiction.

(2) The appeal shall be made by filing a notice of appeal in the Court of Appeal within twenty days after the decision or order appealed from and the rules of court respecting appeals apply with the necessary changes.

The information in this Order is confidential until the price changes take effect. Any unauthorized use or communication of this information by licensees or their employees, and in particular, any disclosure of the contents of this Order to the public, or to the media, prior to 12:01 a.m. on the date in which these price changes come into effect, is strictly prohibited, and may result in license suspension or monetary penalty.
