UPON notification of the suspension of the federal fuel excise tax on gasoline and diesel sold in Prince Edward Island effective April 20, 2026, pursuant to Schedule I of the *Excise Tax Act*, this will result in a decrease in petroleum product prices on April 20, 2026. The table below shows the price per litre impact by product:

Product	Federal Excise Tax (Existing)	Federal Excise Tax (Effective April 20, 2026)	Difference
Regular Gasoline	10.0	0.0	-10.0

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the *Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission Act* and the *Petroleum Products Act*;

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. the prices contained in the attached Retail Dealer Pump Prices shall be effective 12:01 a.m. on Monday, April 20, 2026;
2. the prices contained in the attached Maximum Consumer Petroleum Prices Schedule shall be the maximum prices charged by the respective licensee, effective 12:01 a.m. on Monday, April 20, 2026;
3. the attached dealer prices, with H.S.T. added, shall be indicated on all documents accompanying deliveries of these products; and
4. the prices determined in this Order, with adjustments resulting from tax changes only, shall remain in effect until otherwise ordered by the Commission.

NOTICE:**Section 58 of the *Petroleum Products Act* reads as follows:**

58. Where any person has the status of a party or is an intervenor in any hearing before the Commission, he is entitled

(a) to appeal the decision of the Commission to the Court of Appeal; and

(b) to participate as a party in the hearing of an appeal.

*and an appeal shall be on a question of law or jurisdiction only and be governed by section 13 of the *Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission Act*.*

Subsections 13(1) and (2) of the *Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission Act* provide as follows:

13.(1) An appeal lies from a decision or order of the Commission to the Court of Appeal upon a question of law or jurisdiction.

(2) The appeal shall be made by filing a notice of appeal in the Court of Appeal within twenty days after the decision or order appealed from and the rules of court respecting appeals apply with the necessary changes.
