Conditions of Permit

- 1. Total sewer project costs, including inspection and engineering, to be cost shared as per the application filed November 1, 2010.
- 2. Treatment plant portion of the project to be awarded via public tendering. Sludge removal to be awarded by invited tender, with a minimum of three.
- 3. If applicable, easement(s) to be obtained where main(s) cross(es) private property.
- 4. Certificate of inspection by design engineer, as-built plans and detailed final contract costs to be filed with the Commission, when available.
- 5. Prior to commencement, project must receive approval from the Department of Environment Energy and Forestry.
- 6. This Permit expires if project not completed within twelve (12) months of the Permit issuance date.

This Permit, when signed below, authorizes the Applicant to proceed with the project described above subject to the conditions contained herein.
